

## Lakeview Garden

Enjoy the serenity of Lakeview Garden .The garden surrounds this new home with quiet elegance. A well-planned design uses hardscape and vertical plantings to provide privacy and enhance the formal design of the house.

Copper lanterns invite guests into the parking court. Short brick walls break up the entry area and provide privacy from the street. Notice the crabapple trees that are espaliered along the front wall. They soften the front and provide vertical interest. Look for other examples of espalier as you walk through this garden.

Lakeview Garden was designed to be enjoyed during each season. Korean, English and American boxwood are used throughout the garden to provide structure and year-round color. Varied texture is provided by arborvitae and podocarpus.

A wide flagstone path wraps around the house, leading guests to the outdoor entertaining area which features a stone patio covered by a pergola. This welcoming area faces the lake. Limelight hydrangeas and Korean boxwoods are planted in front of the stone retaining wall.

This compact garden features daylilies, ferns and roses. It is a great example of creating a seamless blend between the architecture of the home and the architecture of the garden.
